In November 2025, The Infomaniacs release their second album '**Fermata**'. Recorded at La Chunky Studios in Glasgow the album is packed full of melodic delights and includes the singles '**24 Panels Of Light**' & '**The Mistake**' as well as live favourites '**Who Stole The Sun?**' and '**A Pause For Thought**'.

Fermata follows up the band's well received acoustic flavoured debut album '**Geography & Luck**' and has more of a full band electric feel reflective of the band's current five piece guitar band live sound. The Infomaniacs would point to musical influences such as The Byrds, Go-Betweens, Julian Cope, the Who, World Party, The Beatles, Love, The La's, Neil Young, Echo & The Bunnymen and Elliott Smith as reference points although these tastes are only really represented with the occasional subconscious nod to the original artists in the search for a more original Infomaniacs blend.

In 2022 The Infomaniacs became a five piece with the addition of **Michael Gahagan** on drums with **Marc Tuffley** swapping the drum stool for a place out front on electric guitar duties. Indeed, one of the defining sounds of the album is the twin electric guitar attack from Marc and **David Andrews**, a striking new feature of the band's sound, perfectly complementing **Neil Menzies'** melodic bass lines and **Michael Gaughan's** creative and energetic drum parts, producing a more electric and dynamic sound than the band's previous long player.

The Infomaniacs launch the new album with a couple of live dates in Glasgow in October / November 2025 with more dates to follow around the UK in the early part of 2026.
